## INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

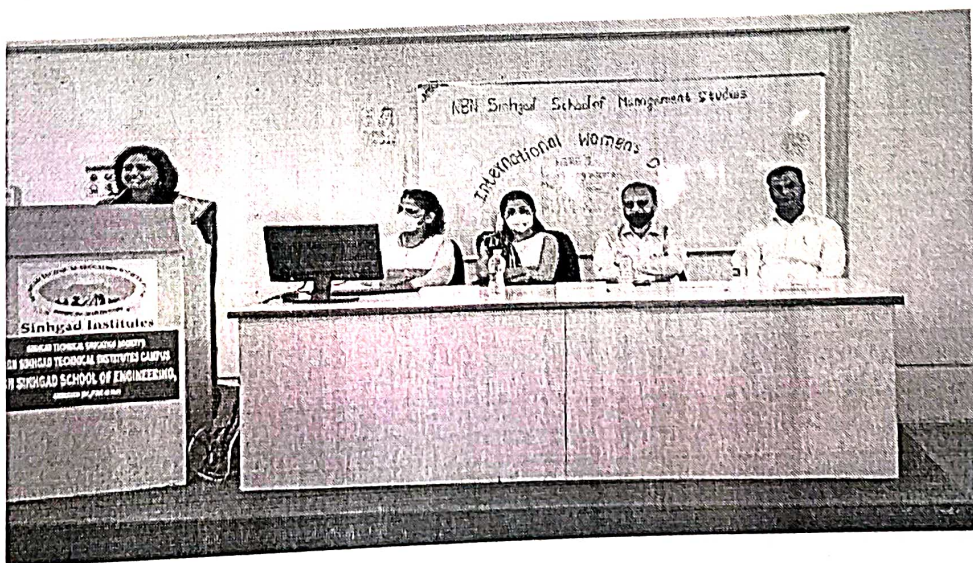
