- **EVENT DESCRIPTION (Ambience, Format, Summary).**

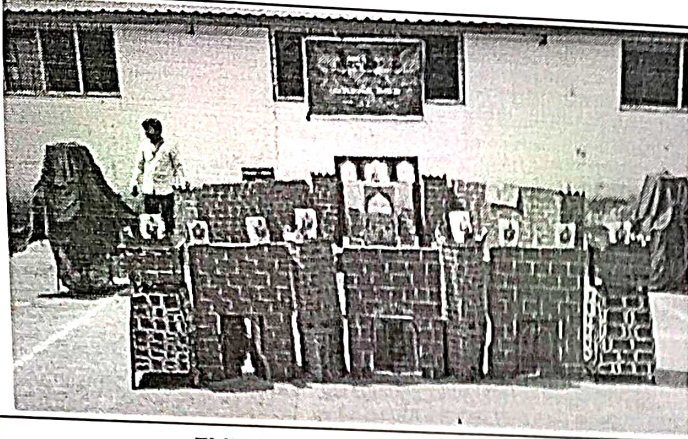

Only one skip is allowed during the race.

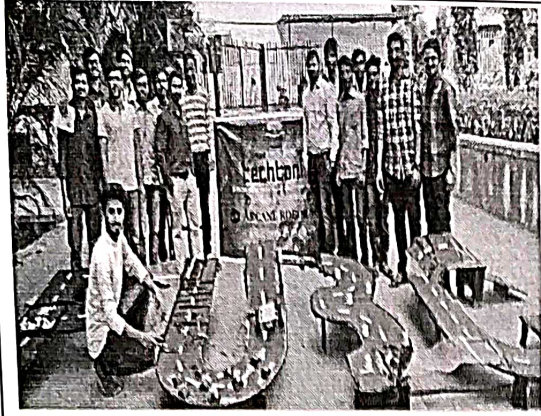
Teams are not allowed to damage any part of the arena. If found doing so, the concerned team will be disqualified.

A report on "Lathe War" Competition - Techtonic 2019

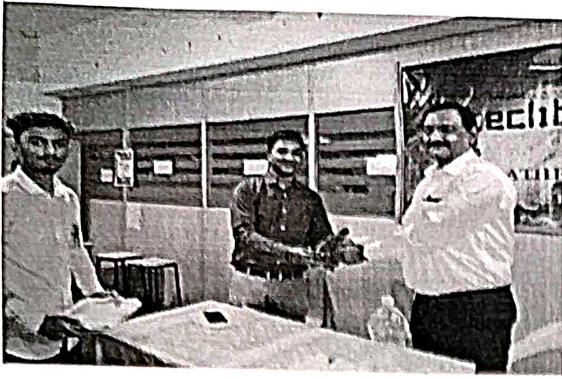

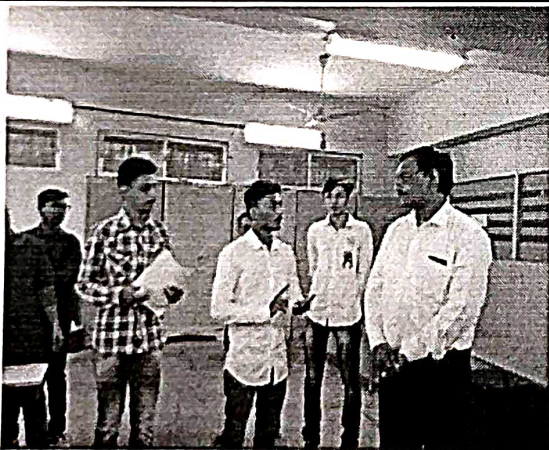
