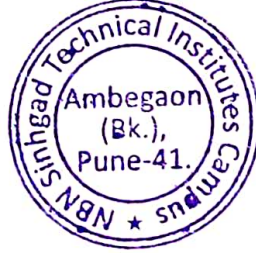

Special winter camp is an integral part of National Service Scheme. It has special appeal to the youth as it provides unique opportunities to the students for group living, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with local community.

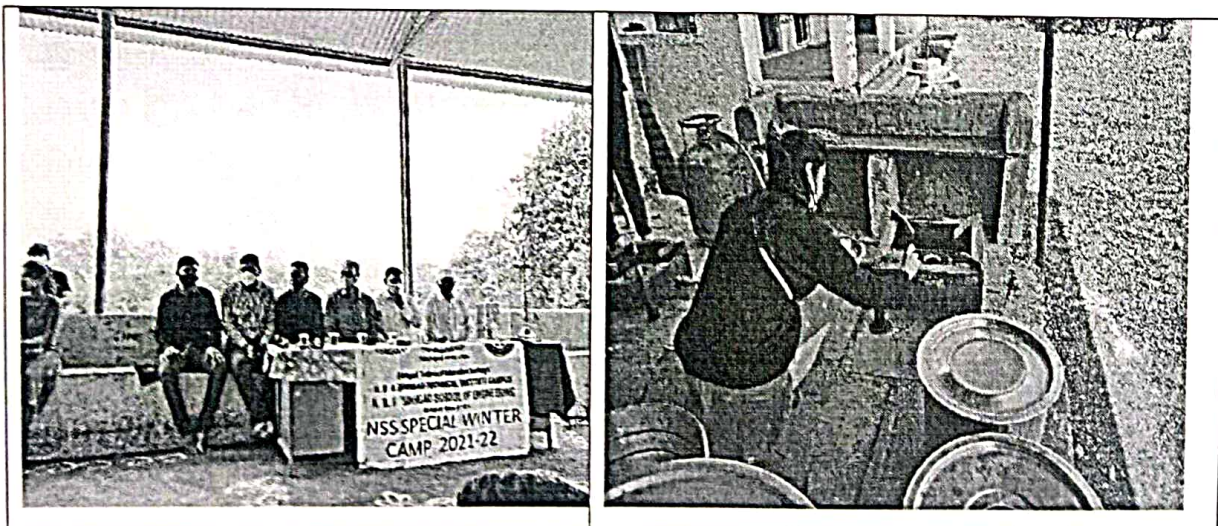
NSS NBNSTIC organized the "NSS Special Winter Camp 2021-22" from Monday, 3rd January, 2022 to Sunday, 9th January, 2022 with the theme as "Youth for sustainable development with special focus on environment enrichment". 50 volunteers from NSS NBNSTIC participated in the 7-day residential camp at Vajeghar Kh., Tal. Velhe, Dist. Pune and contributed to this special winter camp.

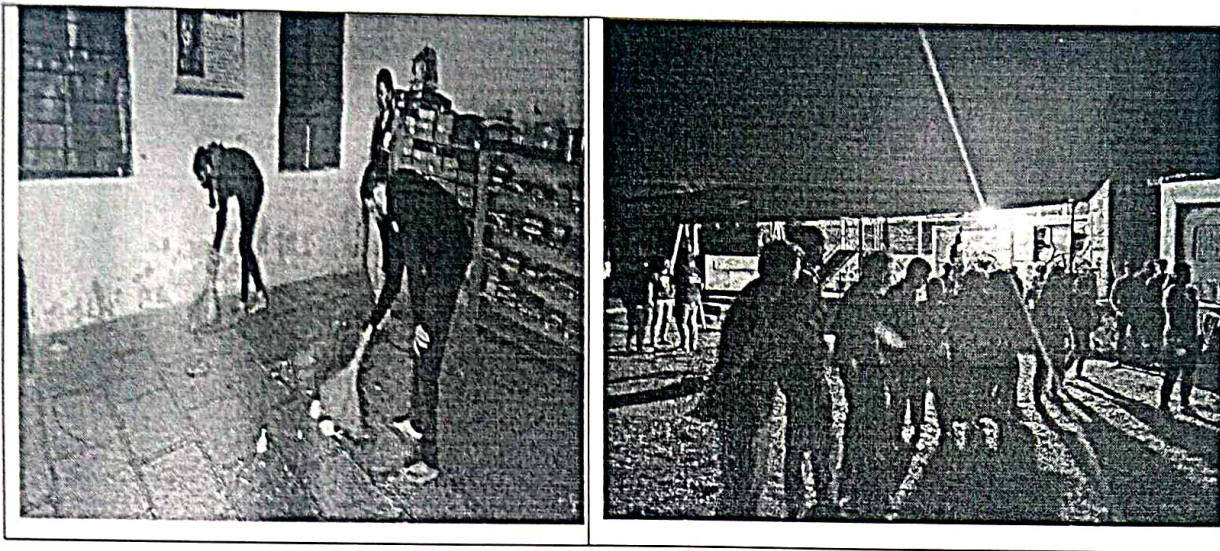


❖ Day 1: Monday, 3rd January, 2022: -

The inauguration of NSS special winter camp was done by Dr. Shivprasad Patil (Director, NBNSTIC) along with Prof. Shailesh Bendale (HoD, Computer Department), Prof. Sharad Patil (HoD, Electrical Department), Prof. Sumit Mali (NSS Program Officer), Shri. Mohan Bharam (Police Patil, Vajeghar Kh.), Shri. Balasaheb Bharam, Prof. Mohan Yelpale, Prof. A. V. Thakare and villagers of Vajeghar (Kh.). The ceremony started with lightning of lamp followed by Saraswati Pujan. Then NSS song was performed by the female volunteers of NSS. Following that principal Dr. Shivprasad Patil motivated volunteers to express their unity and teamwork through the work they were going to perform. He shared his valuable insights throughout his interaction. NSS Program Officer Prof. Sumit Mali provided the complete 7-day program overview and guided the volunteers and villagers about the objectives of the camp.

The day then moved ahead with the survey of village area, population, cleaning and maintenance work of the premises where volunteers were going to stay for next seven days. The day concluded with cultural activities among the volunteers of NSS NBNSTIC.

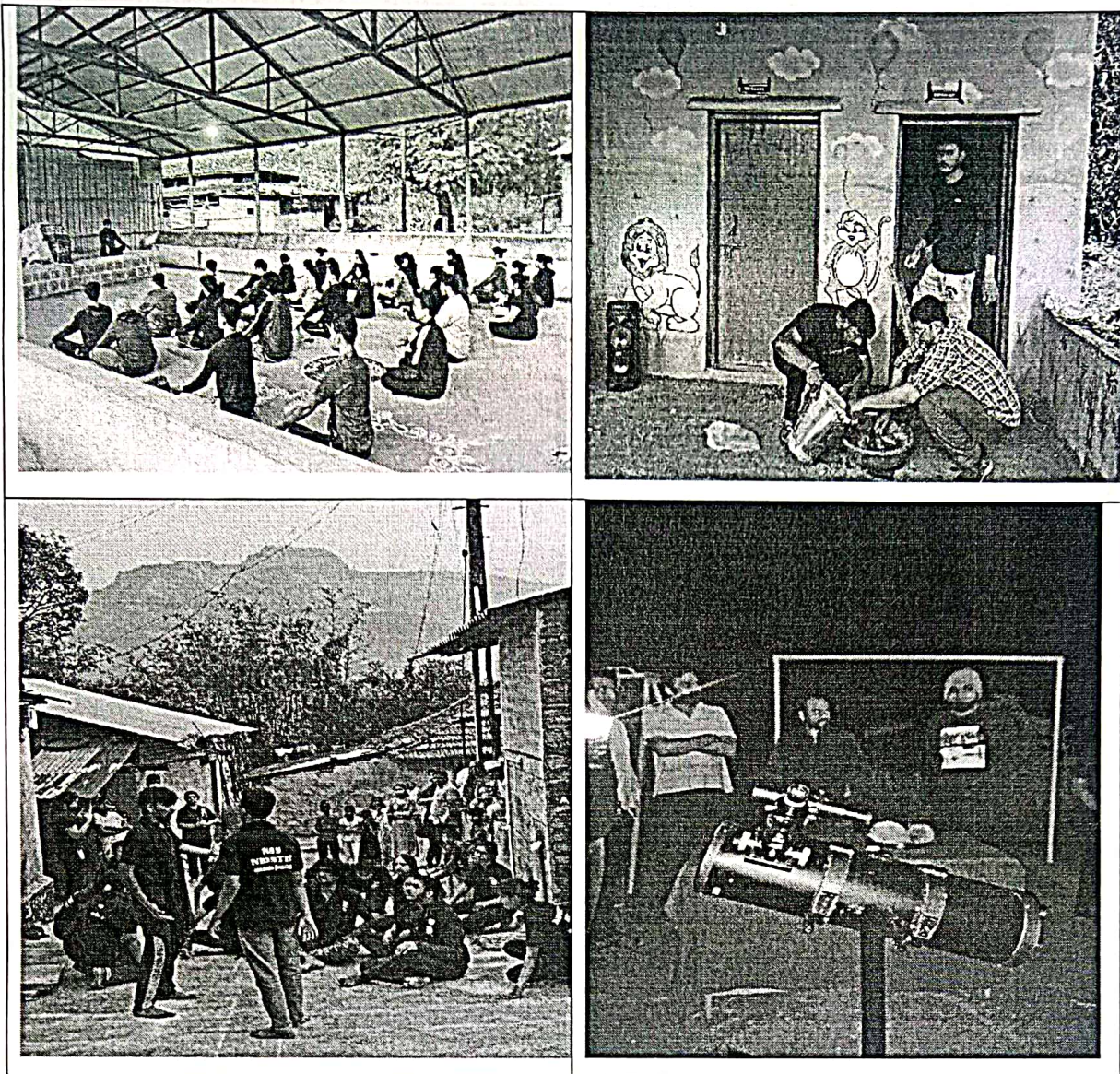




❖ **Day 2: Tuesday, 4th January, 2022: -**

Day 2 started with the jogging and running exercise in the early morning followed by yoga and meditation session under the guidance of NSS volunteers Ms. Ritika Rawat and Mr. Hanumant Naikwade. After breakfast, volunteers were divided into various teams and started their respective works. The school premises cleaning team started with cutting of grass in the school area and worked on maintenance of school playground area. The CCT (Continuous Contour Trenches) team started the maintenance work of CCT in the hilly region of the village. The team completed the work with 12 CCT target locations. The maintenance team performed the necessary repairs of flooring of the Anganwadi toilet. In the evening, the street play team performed a street play on the topic of “Women Empowerment”. After dinner on the same day, an informative session was conducted on the topic of “Astronomy” by the astronomer Mr. Pranav Pujari and Mr. Jameer Manur. They were accompanied by 2 telescopes through which they showed live imagery of the Jupiter planet along with its natural satellites followed by imagery of Andromeda galaxy and explained various constellation formations of stars present in open sky. They also shared their knowledge and experience of deep sky watching with the volunteers. The day concluded with the same session that lasted till the late night.

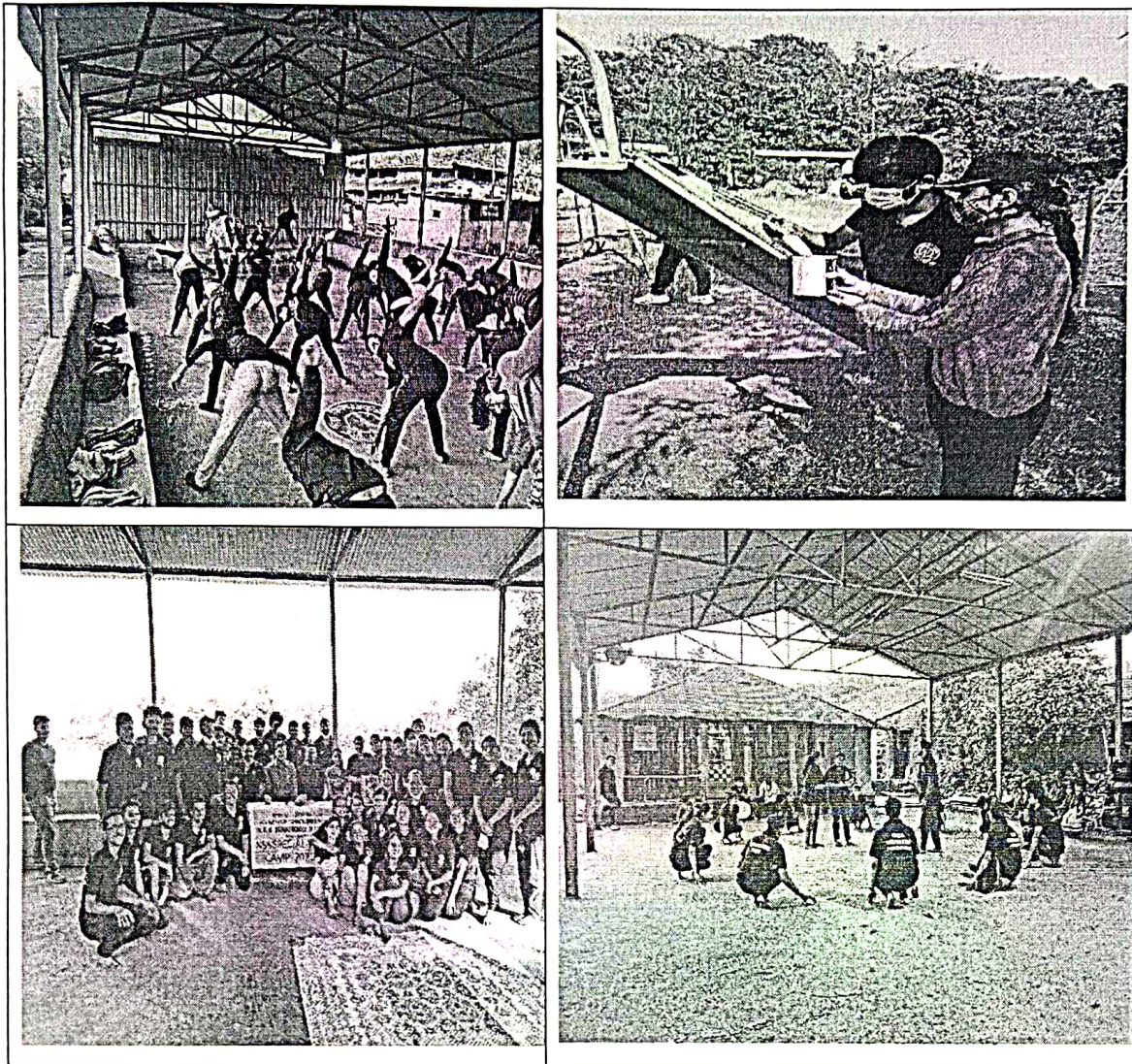




❖ Day 3: Wednesday, 5th January, 2022: -

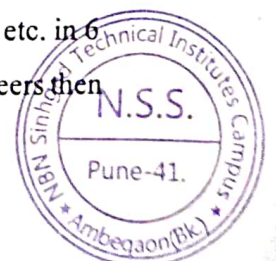
Day 3 also started with the jogging and running exercise in the early morning followed by the yoga and meditation session. After breakfast, the school cleaning team moved ahead with their work in the backyard of the primary school. The maintenance team started their work on the playing equipment's present in the school premises. They started by rubbing and de-rusting of the metallic playing equipment. The CCT team completed the work with 14 CCT target locations. After lunch on the same day, a training session was conducted on the topic of "Yoga and Fitness" by yoga instructor and trainer Mr. Omesh Satbhai and Mrs. Snehal Singh. He shared his brief insights about the role of fitness in daily lifestyle of the students and also explained the importance of balanced diet & healthy sleeping pattern. He also guided the volunteers about the probable work that can be done in the village area through his previous experiences. In the evening, the street play was performed at various locations in the village on

the topic of "Farmer's Suicide". The day concluded with the sports activities among the volunteers.

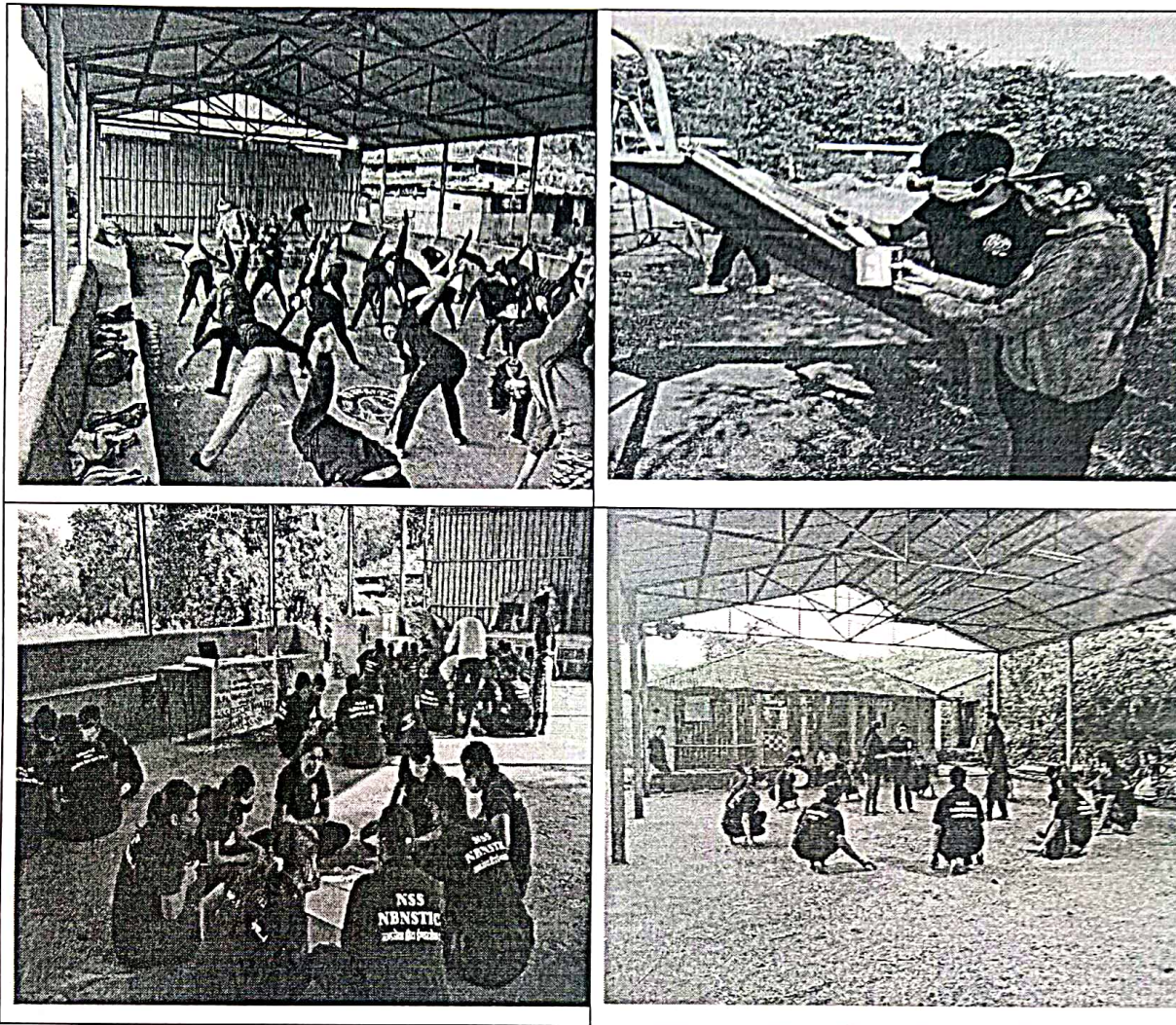


❖ Day 4: Thursday, 6th January, 2022: -

Day 4 started with usual morning exercise and meditation routine along with jogging and running exercises. After breakfast, the cleaning team continued its work towards the village temple area. The maintenance team started its work on painting of the playing equipment. The CCT team completed the work with 14 CCT target locations. In the afternoon after the lunch, founders of Ashwas foundation came for the visit to the camp. Mr. Abhishek Kolhe and Mrs. Aboli paid visit and conducted a session on waste management of different kinds of waste. Volunteers then created a short presentation and posters of various kinds of waste management ranging from household waste, industrial waste, etc. to medical waste, sanitary waste, etc. in 6 different groups and brainstormed their ideas together through this activity. The volunteers then

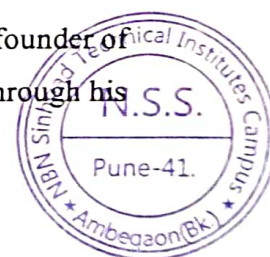


dug the pits in school premises for the tree plantation activity that was planned for the following day. In the evening, the street play was performed on the topic of “Child Labour” at various village locations. The day ended with the volunteer’s playing volleyball and outdoor sports activities.

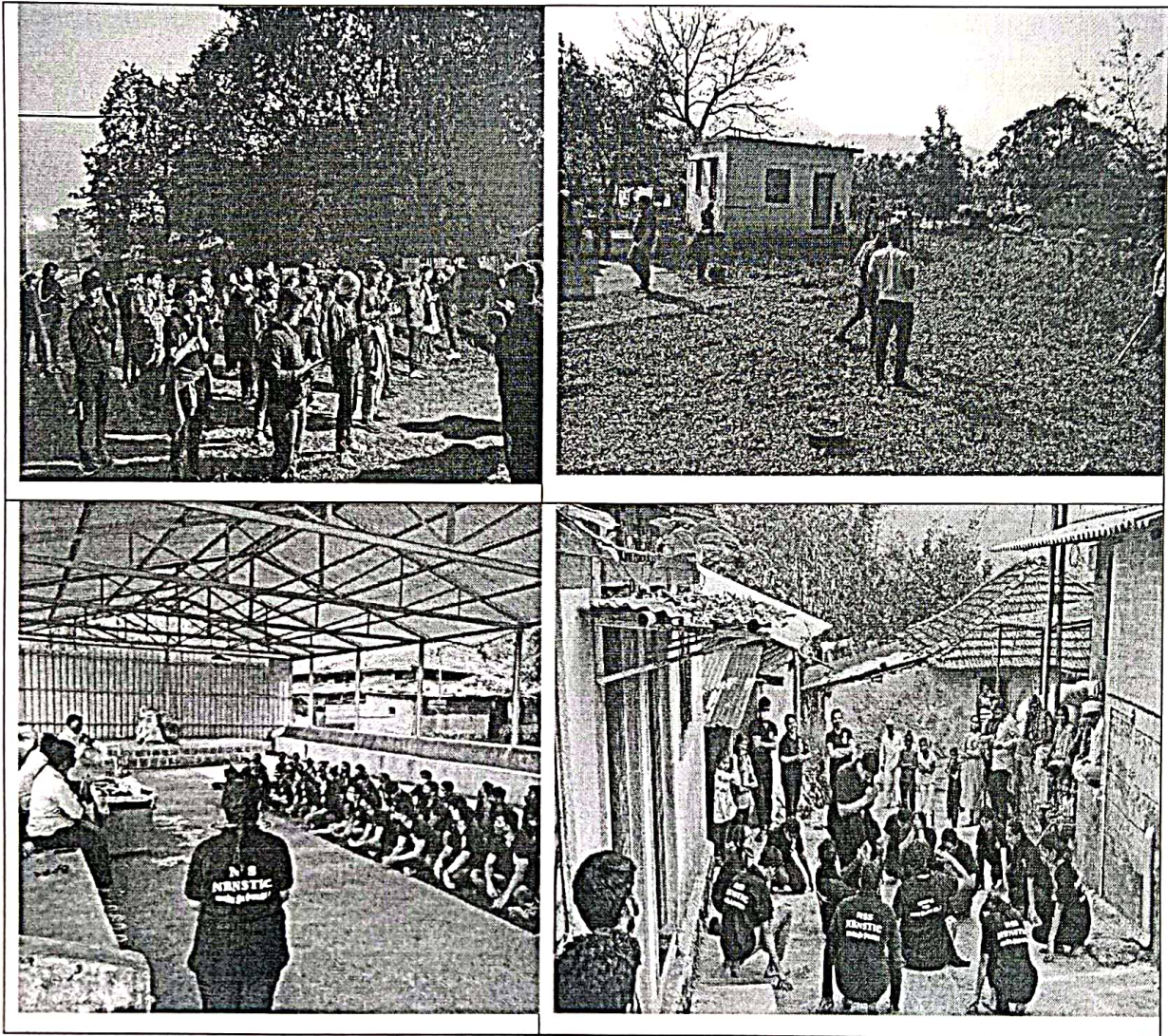


❖ Day 5: Friday, 7th January, 2022: -

Day 5 also started with the healthy morning exercise routine and meditation session. After breakfast, the cleaning team shifted to the cleaning works of primary healthcare center. They cleaned the entire premises and the backyard of the primary healthcare center. The maintenance team continued its pending work of colouring the equipment and maintenance of the wall colour given last year by the previous NSS volunteers. The CCT team completed the work with 16 CCT target locations. After lunch, a session was conducted by Mr. Piyush Shah, founder of Love Care Share foundation. He guided the volunteers and young village students through his

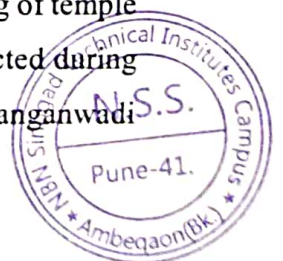


session topic of “Youth and Career Guidance”. He shared his deep insights through his volunteering experience and appealed young generation to contribute to the nation’s growth through their continuous and comprehensive involvement. The volunteers then planted the local plant saplings in the premises of the primary school in the pits that were dug the previous day. In the evening the street play was performed on the topic of “Eradication of Blind Faith” at the selected village locations. The day concluded with the sports and cultural activities amongst the volunteers.

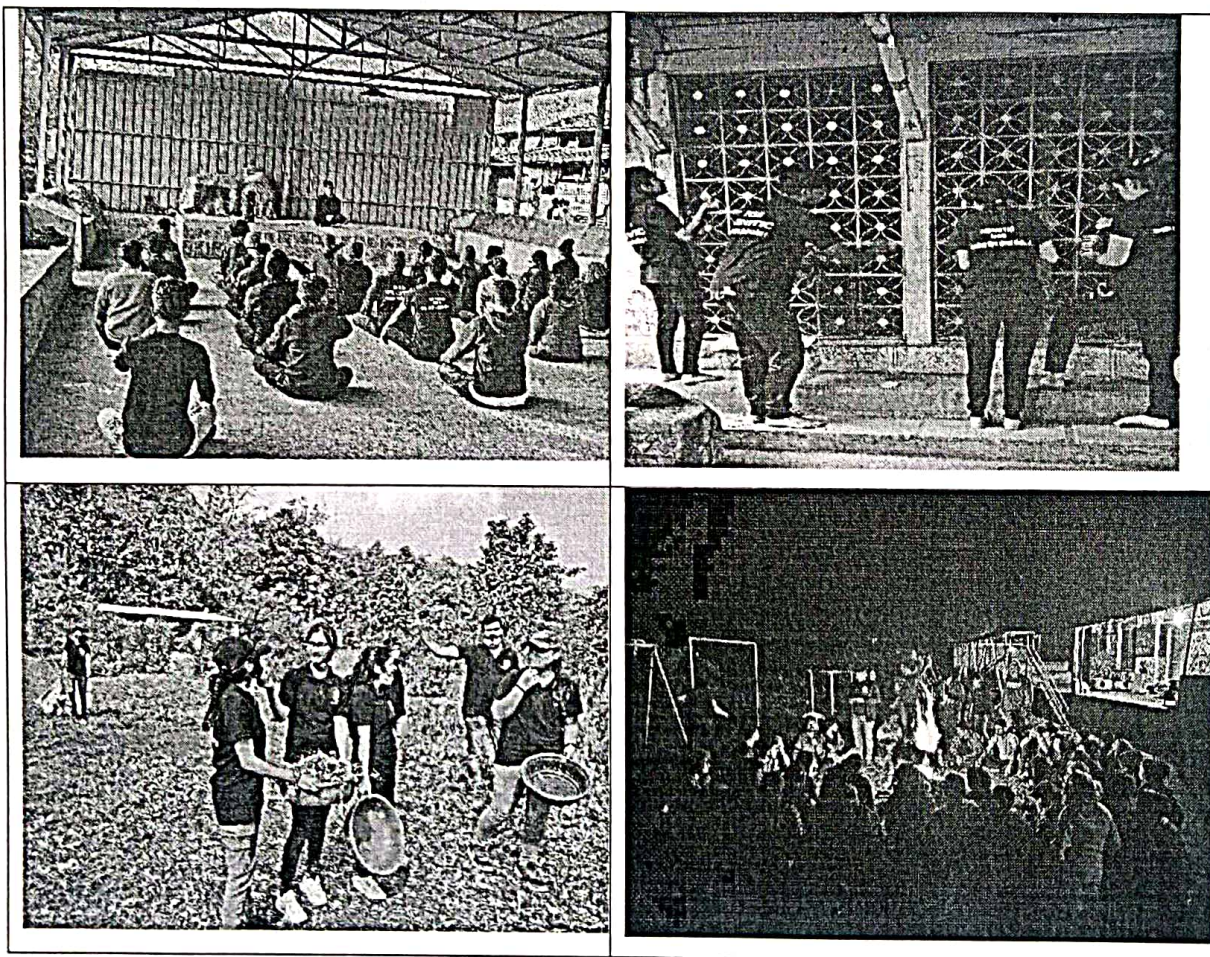


❖ Day 6: Saturday, 8th January, 2022: -

Day 6 started with the usual running, exercise and yoga routine. After breakfast, the maintenance team started finishing up their pending works and shifted to the painting of temple premises. Cleaning team started the disposal of the waste materials they had collected during the complete cleaning activities. They cleaned the backyards and premises of the Aanganwadi



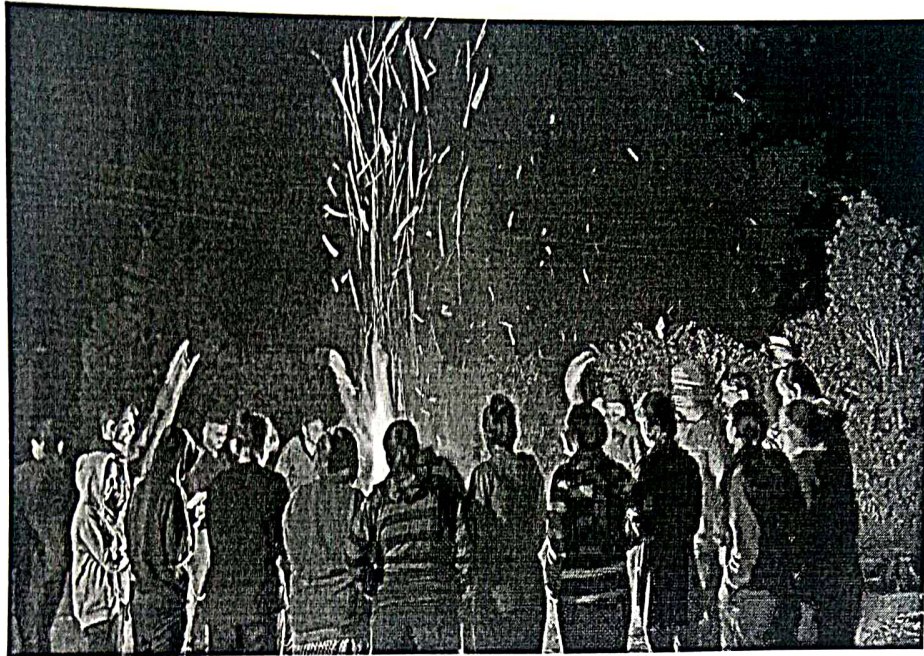
center. The CCT team completed the work with 18 CCT target locations and finished up the work of CCT as per the early planning. In the afternoon, a training session was conducted on the topic of "Self Defense" by Mr. Jasmeet Singh. He trained the volunteers for their own protection and motivated them to be vigilant all the time. He guided female volunteers regarding the self-defense techniques and their usage during the case of emergency. In the evening, the street play team performed a "Powala" on Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj and his glories. After dinner, a camp fire activity was organized where all the volunteers performed various cultural activities like singing, dancing, guitar playing, story recitation, etc. Volunteers even shared their experience of NSS special winter camp and the stories associated with it. In the end, NSS program officer Prof. Sumit U. Mali shared his experience of organizing and conducting of this NSS camp. The day concluded with camp fire activity that lasted till late night.



❖ Day 7: Sunday, 9th January, 2022: -

The final day of the NSS special winter camp started on a different note. After breakfast, the volunteers started cleaning of the premises where they had stayed for last 7 days. All the activities started earlier were completed and came to conclusion on this final day. The camp ended by a closing ceremony by the NSS volunteers. The villagers praised and appreciated the efforts of all the volunteers and faculty members for the success of this special winter camp. The volunteers had their lunch and left for the college campus late in the evening.

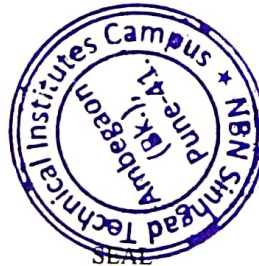
