The club ensures maximum participation as new voters. This club will function based on the rules stipulated by Election Commission of India and Government of Maharashtra.</p>
<p>Whether students' co-ordinator and co-ordinating faculty members are appointed by the College</p> <p>NBNSTIC has appointed Mr. Shishupal Yelgatte, Asst. Prof. working as a Nodal officer for coordinating EL-Club activity for voting awareness and citizen rights. The EL- Club comprises one student representative from each class of Engineering and Management studies. Thereafter Nodal officer will appoint students to work as Campus Ambassador, Chairman and vice Chairman.</p>
<p>Whether the ELCs are functional?</p> <p>NBNSTIC EL-Club is established with aim to know citizen rights to make our nation grow. Further, the institute will build supporting system to make aware of the importance of voter registration Id in student and faculty community. It will strengthen electoral participation of students and staff by performing various activities listed below:</p> <p>Ballot Bistro: In this activity students will discuss about electoral procedure, EVM awareness etc. to increase the voting percentage.</p> <p>Wall Magazine: This club will provide for students as well as faculty members to post articles, poem, drawing and other composition to educate and increase the awareness and participation in electoral process.</p> <p>Debate Competition: Debates and discussions are a great way for conversation to get going amongst the youth. ELC member stakes conversation by organizing inter-college competition. Election debate competition increases political accountability. It improves critical thinking skills. It enhances teamwork skills and collaboration.</p> <p>Motivators Invite: In this activity, informal interactive meets with non-partisan personalities and youth icon like activists and social entrepreneurs are invited.</p>
<p>Whether the ELCs are representative in character?</p> <p>NBNSTIC EL-Club are representative in character to develop a culture of electoral participation and maximize the informed and ethical voting and follow the principle 'Every vote count' and 'No Voter to be Left Behind'.</p>
<p>What innovative programmes and initiatives undertaken by the ELCs? These may include voluntary contribution by the students in electoral processes-participation in voter registration of students and communities where they come from, assisting district election administration in conduct of poll, voter awareness campaigns, promotion of ethical voting, enhancing participation of the under privileged sections of society especially transgender, commercial sex workers, disabled persons, senior citizens, etc.</p> <p>Institute has inaugurated NBNSTIC EL-Club on Jan 04, 2023 by Mr. Tejas Gujarathi, CEO, WE Foundation with the aim to sensitize student as well as staff community about the democratic rights which includes casting votes in elections. Further, club will also celebrate National Voters day every year on Jan 25 with Mock pledge in hybrid mode. It will uphold democratic traditions of our country and dignity of free, ethical and peaceful elections. This will encourage participation of the under privileged sections of society especially transgender, commercial sex workers, disabled persons, senior citizens and fresh voters to vote in every election fearlessly and without being influenced by consideration of religion, race, community, caste, language or any inducement.</p>
<p>Any socially relevant projects/initiatives taken by College in electoral related issues especially Research projects, surveys, awareness drives, creating content, publications highlighting their Contribution to advancing democratic values and participation in electoral processes, etc.</p> <p>NBNSTIC EL-Club has conducted a survey at institute level to list out students & faculty count those are registered and not registered for voting. Special registration camp will be arranged to register fresh voters. The club will also conduct mock polling activity to give experience based learning of the democratic set-up. Further, awareness program such as essay writing competition, debates, elocution, inviting motivators for mock parliaments etc. will also be organised to create more awareness regarding electoral procedures.</p>
<p>Extent of students above 18 years who are yet to be enrolled as voters in the electoral roll and efforts by ELCs as well as efforts by the College to institutionalize mechanisms to register eligible students as voters.</p> <p>As per the norms of Election Commission of India, institutes club representatives will arrange special registration</p>

VISION

To inculcate education on citizen rights for voting and participation in elections from an early age

OBJECTIVES

- To educate the targeted populations about voter registration, electoral process and related matters through hands on experience.
- To facilitate EVM and VVPAT familiarization and education about the robustness of EVM as well as the integrity of the electoral process using EVMs.
- To help the target audience understand the value of their vote and exercise their right to franchise in a confident, comfortable and ethical manner.
- To harness the potential of ELC members for carrying the electoral literacy in communities.
- To facilitate voter registration for its eligible members who are not yet registered.
- To develop a culture of electoral participation and maximize the informed and ethical voting and follow the principle '*Every vote counts*' and '*No Voter to be Left Behind*'.

Functions

- They will organize activities like outreach programs and in campus programs with targeted groups to create voting awareness.
- They shall function towards the goal to create and preserve the literature for the club.

Process Adopted for selecting Student Coordinators

- The club would be run by an elected body from amongst the ELC member students with elected representatives from each of the classes.
- The committee members can only be students who are already enrolled as voters.
- The elected representatives shall constitute the Executive Committee of the ELC
- The elected representatives will elect one of the representatives as its Chairman and another as Vice Chairman
- The Executive Committee, under the guidance, consultation and supervision of the Nodal Officer will be responsible for organizing the activities of the ELC

The elected body shall endeavor to generate the culture of electoral participation amongst the ELC members and will have the following role:

- Organizing the Club enrolment
- Planning activities for the ELC and developing the calendar of activities for the year
- Supervising the conduct of activities as per the calendar
- Facilitating the enrollment of students not registered as voters

Campus Ambassador wherever they are appointed, will act as the Convener(s) of the ELC and will assist the Nodal Officer in discharge of their functions. The Convener shall be responsible for:

- Identifying and involving student members in organizing various ELC activities
- Conducting activities under the overall guidance of the Executive Committee and Mentor/ Nodal Officer
- Any other task assigned by the Executive Committee and Mentor/Nodal Officer
